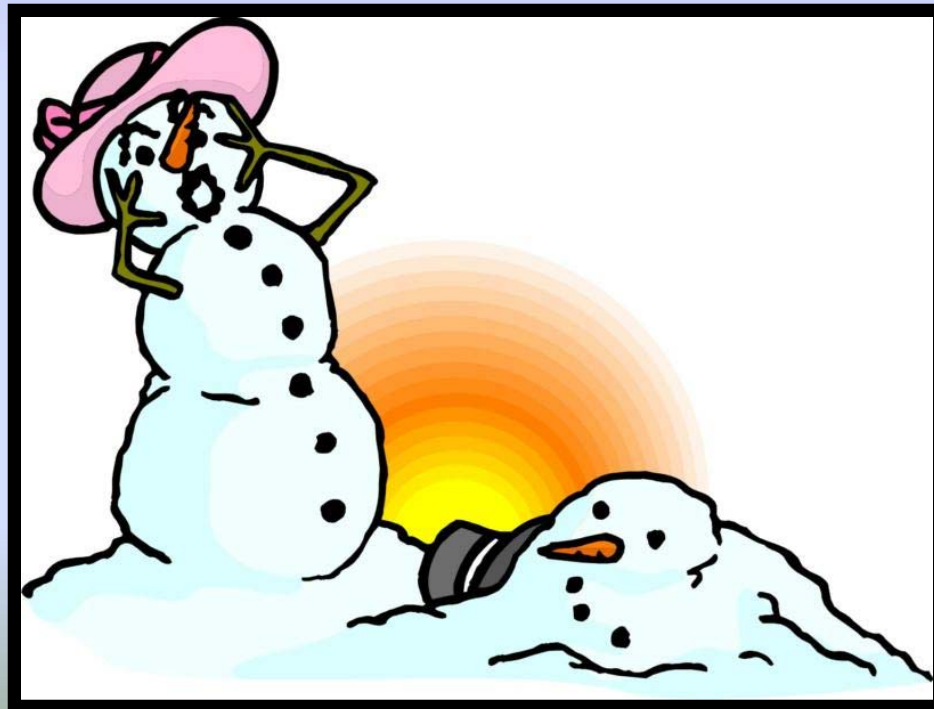


angst: noun

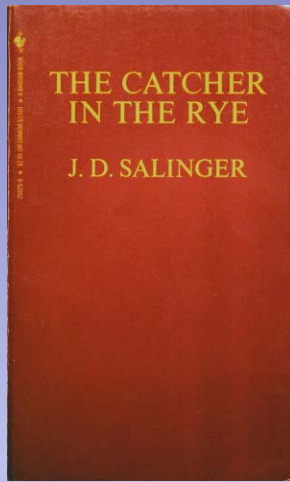
Angst can feel like a vise grip is crushing one's head.
